

## **9. Other Provisions**

### **9.1 Verifications**

The importer may be asked to provide additional documentation and information to support his request for preferential treatment, if the Norwegian customs authorities are in doubt at the time of the customs clearance whether the goods are entitled to preferential tariff treatment or not.

If local Norwegian customs authorities finds it necessary to carry out investigations at the premises of the foreign producer or exporter, or wishes to get further information from abroad, the issue will be raised through the Directorate of Customs and Excise. The directorate will send a request to the authorities in the GSP-country concerned for clarification of the facts. The provisions regarding verification are laid down in § 8-5-13 of the Customs Regulation. In such cases of verification in the GSP-country concerned, the importer may have the goods released from customs control if paying the total amount of customs duties and other charges, or if providing satisfactory security for these amounts
