

Important changes

- From April 1 2025:
 - All goods must be placed under a customs procedure, and a declaration must be submitted before or, at the latest, on crossing the border for all means of transport
- Stipulation of declaration requirements for customs warehouse procedure
- Stipulation of declaration requirements for Notification and Disclosure of Information obligation



Declaration requirements for customs warehouse procedure

- Implemented in TVINN
- Different requirements for customs warehouses A/B and C/D



Declaration requirements, notification and disclosure of information obligation

- Major changes since the first public consultation in the fall of 2022
- No longer declaration at commodity level
- Declarations are made at three levels:
 - Transport level
 - Master consignment level
 - House consignment level

Changes to API

- Public consultation 2 proposes fewer information elements than the current Notification and Disclosure of Information solution
- Less information about the operator
- No requirement for detailed information about goods at house consignment level
- Reduction in the sum of data to be submitted

Future regulatory process

- Further work on adjustments to laws and regulations to continue
- New public consultation planned for the beginning of 2024:
 - Adaptations for transport by air, sea and rail
 - Exception arrangements, including temporary warehousing
 - Possible adjustment to declaration requirements

New API for Digitoll


- Testing available from 10 August

- After October 1st 2023, everyone must have transitioned to the new API.
- Until the new API is up and running, recruitment of new Digitoll businesses should be suspended





Each method of transport will have its own API

The concept is that each method of transport shall have a separate API. In principle, the APIs are alike.





Obligation of declaration (TVINN)

New customs legislation in force. Exception arrangements: direct transport permitted

01.01.23

Opportunity for digital submission and processing of all declarations before/on border crossing

Direct transport arrangement phased out for all transport means. Declaration requirement before/on crossing border for customs warehouse procedure.




- Functionality for processing declarations up to 5 days before crossing border implemented 05.01.2023.
- Moving towards a common expedition unit
- The current units are:
 - 371002 for Svinesund
 - 372002 for Ørje
 - 441002 for Ferry
- 441002 will eventually be the only Digitoll expedition unit, and new customs offices with Digitoll will use this.
- Batch customs clearances (samlefortolling) will still be processed in the same manner as at present, until we have reviewed other solutions.





Digital notification and disclosure of information

- The solution is ready for use at Svinesund and Ørje
- Opened at customs offices at Åsnes, Østby, Vauldalen, Bjørnefjell and Helligskogen May 31st
- Opening at customs offices at Polmak, Neiden and Junkerdalen June 19th
- The solution will be rolled out for all transport means in the period November 2022 July 2024
- MO Fly planned for October 2nd 2023
- Principal rule for digital submission March 2025

Pre-notificationn from 3rd countries (ICS2)

- At present, only a few parties have implemented pre-notification in Release 2.
- Most businesses (EOs) have applied for postponement, with final deadline October 2nd.
- 12 member countries in the EU have also had postponement until July 1st approved.
- Until July 1st, the EU has requested air freight transporters to wait to send pre-notification in ICS2 until the first country of arrival has a functioning ICS2 solution.
- Release 3 (sea, road and railway) according to the schedule will be implemented from 1 March 2024, and all prenotifications on import, within 31 March 2025 shall be concluded in the old system NCTS/ICS(EU)
- The Customs Service has begun surveying possible parties (sea, road and railway)
- 200 relevant parties have been identified within sea freight, who transport goods from 3rd countries directly to Norway by ship.
- At present, Norway has no direct transport of freight by railway. but some by road (Storskog at the border with Russia).

NCTS

- In January we informed that the EU will present some minor amendments in the specifications
- Updated specifications have been sent out to relevant system suppliers
